Why create a QR Code?

Creating a QR Code is a simple way to direct donors to your Virtual Fill the Boot website. It is helpful to have on posters, in newspaper articles, and on boots at stores in your local community. It is also helpful to put it on boots as fire fighters are out doing traditional Fill the Boot at store fronts. Donors can easily scan the code with their phone and will be directed to your local's Virtual Fill the Boot website.

DO NOT CLICK THE "START" BUTTON! Click on the URL tab and copy and paste your local's page link where it says "Enter URL" and a QR code will generate automatically. Simply download the QR code by clicking on the "save" button in the green box.
