75 Years of Impact. 71 Years of Partnership.

In 2025, the Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) marked its 75th anniversary, celebrating decades of progress for families living with neuromuscular disease. For 71 of those years, the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) has stood alongside MDA through the Fill the Boot program, helping to raise more than \$721 million in support of our shared mission. What began in 1954 as a local act of service has grown into one of the longest-standing partnerships in the nonprofit sector, carried forward by generations of fire fighters committed to offering hope and a brighter future for families.

As MDA reflects on 75 years of impact, our partnership with the IAFF continues to evolve to meet emerging and urgent needs. In recent years, growing concerns about the potential link between firefighting and ALS have driven increased collaboration between our organizations. Building on the IAFF MDA ALS Initiative launched in 2024, our work remains focused on advancing ALS research within the fire service, developing fire fighter specific research efforts, creating accessible co-branded resources, and providing critical support to fire fighters and families affected by ALS. As IAFF General President Ed Kelly has emphasized, even after seven decades, the work is not done and fire fighters will continue to go where the fight is.

2025 also marked a new chapter for MDA with the appointment of Dr. Sharon Hesterlee as President and CEO. A seasoned leader in neuromuscular research and drug development, Dr. Hesterlee brings deep scientific expertise and a strong commitment to translating discovery into meaningful, everyday impact for families. As MDA looks to the future, guided by community voices and strengthened by long-standing partners like the IAFF, we remain focused on accelerating progress, expanding care, and ensuring no family faces neuromuscular disease alone.

Science & Advocacy

For 75 years, MDA has been the nation's leading nonprofit driving research and innovation in neuromuscular diseases (NMDs), investing more than \$1.1 billion to date. This enduring commitment has fueled discoveries that led to more than 30 FDA-approved treatments in the past decade alone, transforming care and improving quality of life for individuals and families living with neuromuscular disease.

MDA's investment has also built the future of science by supporting over 7,000 investigators and training more than 2,000 early-career researchers, whose work continues to advance breakthroughs and bring strength and hope to the neuromuscular community.

Here are just a few highlights from 2025:

5 new FDA-approved treatments were approved in 2025, bringing new hope to families living with neuromuscular disease

Duchenne muscular dystrophy added to the national newborn screening panel, working towards earlier diagnosis in all 50 states

6,021 individuals now contributing real-world data through MOVR, accelerating care improvements and treatment development

1,690 clinicians and scientists from 32 countries united to fast-track breakthroughs at the MDA Clinical & Scientific Conference

125 MDA advocates took to Capitol Hill to protect access to care, support medical research funding, and ease the burden on caregivers

Over \$2 million invested in collaborative research, advancing neuromuscular disease treatments

MDA Summer Camp and MDA Family Getaways offer magical, barrier-free experiences that foster inclusion, independence, and lifelong friendships for kids, young adults, and families living with neuromuscular disease. Campers try new activities, develop confidence, and discover more of themselves, while Family Getaways provide accessible recreation and opportunities for connection within families and the neuromuscular disease community.

Fire fighters play a key role in bringing this magic to life. In 2025, 21 fire fighters served as counselors, guiding campers through activities and creating unforgettable experiences. Many more joined for Fire Fighter Day to see firsthand the impact they help make possible through Fill the Boot.


